Funding Source:		The Knights Kids Program is supported by fees paid by participating families. Payments are accepted from the Child Care Assistance program. For more information contact the Social Service office of the county in which you reside.				
Registration Fee:		Early Bird Registration fee is \$30 for families who register by April 26 th . For registrations received after April 26 th the registration fee will be \$40. Checks payable to Knights Kids. Registration fee is non-refundable.

Information at a Glance

- Registration begins immediately; space is available on a first come, first serve basis for Full Time Families with
 <u>completed paperwork and paid registration fee</u>. Registering priority will be given to families registering for Full
 Time, followed by Part Time. Families will be notified by April 28 with confirmation of enrollment or if they have been
 wait-listed. Summer information packet will be available by April 28 to registered families.
- Summer scheduling policies:
 - Full Time → 5 days per week, 10 weeks of the summer is scheduled and the attendance calendar for <u>all</u> three months (June, July and August) are submitted no later than May 10, 2023.
 - Part Time → Minimum of 3 days per week, 10 weeks of the summer is scheduled and the attendance calendar for <u>all three months</u> (June, July and August) are submitted no later than May 10, 2023.
- Knights Kids offers enrichment and recreation-based opportunities designed for your child's age group.
- Camp themes, swimming at the local pool twice a week, walking field trips and special activities.
- Field trips out of town have not been confirmed at the time this document was printed. Information on field trips will be communicated to families in the summer information packet.
- Parents provide lunch and a beverage for their child each day.
- A morning and an afternoon snack are provided by the Knights Kids program.
- Staff are selected for their program skills, experience and ability to work with children.
- Children need to attend to their own personal hygiene. They need to be toilet trained and able to use the bathroom independently.
- Knights Kids is closed June 2 and August 28 September 1 for cleaning and staff development opportunities.
- Swimming at the Kenyon Pool on Monday and Thursday afternoons. Pool fee is included with your child's Knights Kids registration fee.
- Parents will need to make arrangement to get their child to and from swim lessons. Knights Kids staff <u>will not</u> be able to provide this service.
- The following program is available for an additional charge:
 - > K-W Community Education Summer Recreation and Enrichment programs.

Daily Schedule: During the morning hours the children participate in structured choice activities, large motor activities, morning meeting, morning snack and activities based on the camp theme. After lunch children have relaxation and nap time except for on swim days. For the children that do not nap, they participate in tabletop and structured choice activities. More camp theme activities, afternoon snack, outside play and structured choice activities complete the program for the day.
