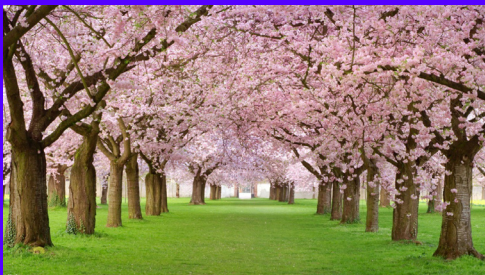

### South Country Health Alliance Minnesota Partners with Community Education

SCHA Minnesota members may take up to a \$15 discount per class on up to five classes per year. To qualify for the discount, the member must be enrolled with SCHA during the month of his/her Community Education class. # Registration Information

## How Do I Register?

- By Mail: Send your check, money order, or credit card information with the completed registration form to: K-W Community Education, 400 Sixth St., Kenyon, MN 55946. Indicate your class number and name on the registration form and include your payment.

## Who Do I Pay?

Please make checks payable to K-W Community Education. Checks will be deposited when received. If a class or registration is canceled a refund check will be distributed.

## When Can I Sign Up?

Registration begins immediately. If space is still available in a class registrations are taken as long as possible, depending on the supplies needed by the instructor. Early registrations help fill classes on time and reduce the chances that the class will be canceled. Thanks for helping Community Education and our instructors by registering as early as possible.

## When are Classes Canceled?

If we do not have the minimum number of registrations needed, a class is canceled when early bird registration ends or one week prior to start date.

## Refunds

If you cannot attend a class you will receive a refund up to one-week prior to the class, unless a deadline is specified. After that date your refund will be based on supplies or fees already incurred. A \$5.00 cancellation fee is applied to all canceled classes.

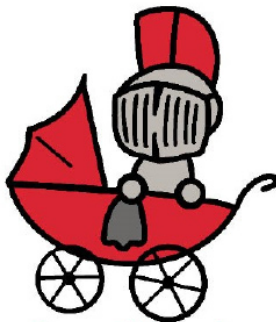

## **Knights Kids Summer Programming**

**33 months - 5th Grade (Fall 2024)**



Knights Kids is a school-age care program that allows kids to experience a variety of enrichment and recreational activities. Our mission is to care for children in a safe, enriching environment that supports the individual needs of children and families while building positive relationships. We offer low staff to student ratios and a variety of enrichment opportunities.

Registration for summer care will be available in March. Care is provided from 6:00 am - 6:00 pm Monday-Friday. Students participate in weekly walking fieldtrips to the pool and library (no additional fees) as well as a few additional fieldtrips throughout the summer. Our summer program is run like a day camp with weekly themes to keep your child engaged and enjoying their summer!

Wanamingo students depart the school at 7:30 am via Hiawathaland Transit and spend the day in Kenyon before returning to Wanamingo at approximately 3:20 for extended day care. There is no additional cost for bussing.
